A word from the mayor

Boosted by the legacy of its natural, historical, and human resources, Boulouparis' population continues to develop and has grown by more than 10% over the last 10 years, passing the threshold of 3,500 inhabitants in 2021. According to the national statistics bureau's population projections, this rate of increase will continue and by 2030 should comprise nearly 5,000 inhabitants. This population increase is further amplified by the high incidence of second homes as the population doubles every weekend.

The demographic evolution of Boulouparis is therefore real and represents a significant challenge in terms of urban planning and in organising the necessary public and private services. This observation is explained by the proximity of Boulouparis to Greater Noumea and the airport activity area, the town being just 20 minutes from Tontouta International airport and 45 minutes from Noumea.

My desire and that of the other elected officials is to anticipate this evolution, to master it and to propose solutions for the future problems it implies and the expectations of the population. In this perspective, we have secured the expertise of 2 essential partners:

With its experience and in-depth knowledge of the territory, SECAL supports us in the realization of a long-term development plan to project Boulouparis's expansion into the near future. Equally, through the quality of its achievements and its philosophy in terms of architecture, the Athanor firm assists us in the revision of the PUD (Urban Development Plan) and also project realization and organisation.

So, my ambition is to contribute to both the development of New Caledonia and the municipality of Boulouparis by examining the area's needs and creating the necessary new facilities. I want to offer investors the opportunity to create new projects, that are the source of jobs and services for the inhabitants of Boulouparis for both today and tomorrow. Together with its neighbouring communities and in a logic of complementarity, this emerging Boulouparis is encouraging the economic world to support and integrate into its development.


The agents at the service of the population and the executive:

- 25 support staff to serve the public.







improves its image

Tomo is the principal urban sector of Boulouparis. Located near the airport and just 45 minutes from Noumea, Tomo offers a remarkable natural and historical site thanks to its coastline, its exceptional view of the bay of St Vincent and its many islets, as well as its ruins that will be the subject of a restoration and cultural enhancement program.

Tomo aims to become a village combining residential calm with a quality of life by the sea. To accompany this evolution, the town hall will secure and renovate the principal road running through the village and embellish the coastline.





THE OUENGHI river spreads

The Ouenghi is one of the many rivers and streams in the commune. It is spanned by a historical monument unique in Oceania, the Ouenghi bridge built by the world-renowned Eiffel workshop. This site will soon become a space for relaxation and safe access to the river.

In the future, it will host new equestrian activities and offer new economic and leisure opportunities, both on and around the site.








Renovation of the **SPORTS** park

Creation of new commercial activities, expansion of the residential areas, and the renovation and rethinking of the Oua Ya Park.


This program aims to revitalize the village of Boulouparis by offering new housing, public facilities, and services for the population.
